### GENERAL TRAINING

Trainings related to information and knowledge sharing meant to assist and improve companies' daily operations and management.

### FUNDING ACCESS TRAINING



Related to information sharing of available funding from public and private sources, these trainings are aimed at getting interested companies ready to engage these funding parties.
